Those young people identified as “at risk” may not require a statutory response and may be receiving appropriate alternative support services in accordance with their level of need.

There are numerous other variables that impact on data quality and accuracy of reporting. Therefore whilst the numbers give an important and relevant insight into the impact of awareness raising activity and scale; direct comparisons between Local Authorities are unlikely to be accurate.
