


## Overview of the CSPR process



actions are being implemented to improve services for children and families

Decision to complete a **local** Child Safeguarding Practice Review.

Panel members confirmed following discussion at Rapid Review meeting with representatives from each partner

agency. Independent Lead Reviewer commissioned by the Business Unit according to nature of review.

Terms of Reference, review methodology and timeline agreed by panel and author – **6 months** is set timeframe for completion (subject to parallel proceedings which may affect publication date)

Draft reports completed and circulated to panel. Final draft submitted to panel to check recommendations and that the report mirrors the Terms of Reference.

Partnership agency leads to ensure the report is shared with their strategic leads and governance bodies including the SCT Board – **14 days** to confirm responses

Final report submitted to SLPR subgroup for approval

Final report signed off by the SCSP Board

National Panel, DfE and Ofsted notified 7 working days prior to publication. Cabinet Member notified via Chair of SCSP.

CSPR published on SCSP website. 7 minute briefing completed to summarise learning and is circulated to all agencies. Multi agency face to face briefing with practitioners held where possible and learning shared with L&D subgroup so training can be updated

SCSP seeks assurance at agreed intervals that agencies are implementing actions from learning and recommendations. Information collated and fed back to the Quality of Practice and Performance subgroup for monitoring.

Decision to complete a **national** Child Safeguarding Practice Review.

> Completion of national review by the National Panel in partnership with the SCSP.
